## What if my details change or I lose my card?

### If you move house

Please visit the Victoria Travel Centre as soon as possible and complete a change of address form. You will need to provide details of your new address. If you move out of the City area, you must return your pass to the Victoria Travel Centre.

### If you lose your Senior Robin Hood card

Please report your lost card immediately to the Victoria Travel Centre in person or by calling (0115) 876 1300

### Replacement fee

There is a replacement fee of £10 for lost or damaged cards. If your card has been stolen and you can provide a crime number, the replacement fee will be waived.

You can also request a replacement for a lost card by calling the Smartcard team on (0115) 876 2700 and paying the replacement fee by credit or debit card.

# Applying for a Senior Robin Hood Card

The Senior Robin Hood Card is available to City residents who have reached the pensionable age determined by the current State Pension.

## National benefits

Free travel on any local bus service in England between 9.30am and 11pm Monday to Friday, and at all other times at weekends and bank holidays.

## Local benefits

These benefits are only applicable within the Nottingham City Council boundary area and only available to City residents.

- Senior Robin Hood Card holders get free tram travel between 9.30am and 11pm Monday to Friday and at all times weekends and bank holidays
- You can apply for a companion pass if you are blind, partially sighted, wheelchair bound or have learning difficulties prohibiting lone travel. (You might be asked to attend an independent medical assessment).

## Am I eligible?

The Senior Robin Hood Card is free to obtain and has no renewal fee.

You can apply if you are both:

- a permanent resident within the Nottingham City Council boundary
- at or above pensionable age as determined by the current State Pension age for women (applies to both men and women).

## Senior Robin Hood Companion Card

The Senior Robin Hood Companion Card gives the same travel benefits as the Senior Robin Hood Card for the card holder and the companion.

You can apply for a Senior Robin Hood Companion Card if you can only travel with the aid of a companion most of the time and you qualify under at least one of the following criteria:

- Sight impaired or partially sighted - must be registered with Nottingham City Council Sensory Team, or;
- A permanent wheelchair user, or;
- Have a severe learning disability - must be under the care of Nottingham City Council Adult Learning Team

Senior Robin Hood Companion Card applicants might be required to attend an independent medical assessment. This assessment is free; however, you will need to cover any transport or other expenses.

## How to apply

You can apply for a Senior Robin Hood Card up to 14 days before you become eligible.

Applications should be made in person at the Victoria Travel Centre, Victoria Bus Station, Nottingham.

A photograph will be taken of you as you stand at the counter and your new pass will be posted to you within 10 working days.

Please bring with you:

- A completed application form
- Documentary proof of City residency (see application form for more details)
- Valid proof of age (see application form)

# Senior Robin Hood Card Application Form

I wish to apply for a companion to travel with me for free. I am applying under the following criteria:

- I am visually impaired and I am registered blind or partially sighted with Nottingham City Council's Adult Sensory Team.
- I need to use a wheelchair at all times (both indoors and outdoors).
- I have a learning disability that prevents me from travelling alone. I am under the care of Nottingham City Council's Adult Learning Disability Team.

I am of state pension age for women (or over) and a permanent resident of Nottingham City. I accept the conditions of the Concessionary Scheme. I understand that the provision of any false information as part of this application may render me liable to prosecution and that the pass remains the property of Nottingham City Council.
